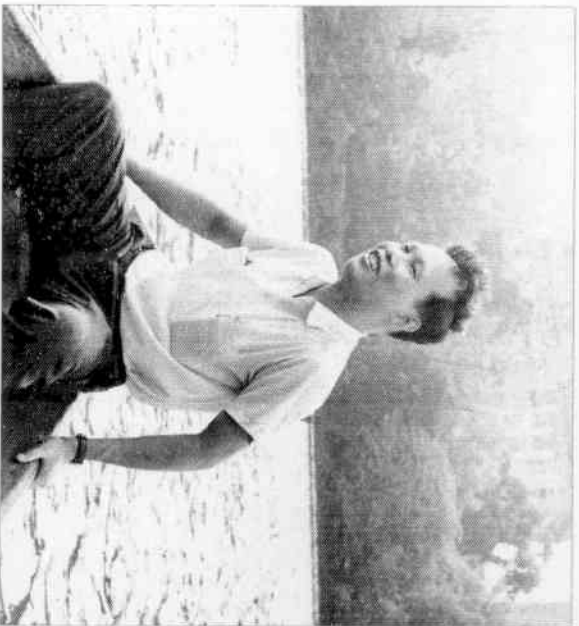

Andrew Leong Yu Chan was born in the village of Law Biu, Sun Wui, Guangdong, China. He died at the age of 69, on October 6, 2007 in Old Bridge, New Jersey.

Born July 6, 1938 to Kiu and the late Wing Chan, he was the oldest of four children. When Andrew was a young man, he attended a teaching college. After graduating, he taught at a school in Sun Wui. He enjoyed teaching and felt a strong sense of responsibility for the education of his students.

He endeavored to live in a free country and so immigrated to Hong Kong in 1957 to continue teaching. In 1961, with the help of his uncles, he entered the United States to further continue his studies. There he pursued a work/study program at a college in Maryland. During a summer between studies, Andrew met his future wife, Rebecca, when they both worked at his uncle's restaurant. In 1966, they married in Baltimore, Maryland.

Together they had three children: Stephen, Lily, and Irene. Stephen and his wife Chou Lan have two sons, Kyle and Derek. Lily and her husband Andrew have three children, Rory, Chloe, and Emma. All are happy and well.

Andrew was always very hard working. After getting married, they started their own business. In 1968, the young couple opened Chung Hsing Restaurant in Old Bridge, NJ. And in 1980, they established China Moon in East Brunswick, NJ.

Kind and generous, Andrew was always ready to lend a hand to friends and relatives, both young and old. His example was a role model for others to follow. Although Andrew is no longer with us, his legacy remains in our hearts and minds.
